Teas from Sri Lankan Rain Forests..

The unique, hand-picked teas are grown by rainforest communities in Sri Lanka.

The dappled woodland of Sri Lanka's rainforests provides the ideal environment for the production of large buds, high in health giving polyphenols. These buds are collected at a critical stage in chlorophyll production, with minimal bruising to ensure peak quality and converted into green and white teas.



Hand Rolled Black Orange Pekoe Tea

Silver Ring tea is a limited edition, individually hand-rolled artisanal white tea with leaves that unfurl when steeped. Packed with antioxidants, it brews to a delicate lime green infusion and the leaves can be used 2 or 3 times. White tea is naturally rich in antioxidants and polyphenols which help keep us healthy.

Hand Rolled Full Bud Green Tea

With our hand-rolled black tea, the whole leaf is maintained without shredding through the fermentation process, ensuring a fine flavor. The tannins brought out by the delicate hand-roll process have many health benefits - strengthening capillaries and stimulating the adrenal gland. It is a light, but full-bodied tea that can have milk added for those who like it. The infused brew is reddish in color.

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Silver Ribbon

Known as the champagne of teas, this special grade of white tea is the least processed of all teas and thus contains the highest concentrates of antioxidants. Silver Ribbon is unique in that it is composed wholly of unopened buds - unlike all other teas, which are made from the opened leaves. The unopened buds have not begun to photosynthesize making them especially low in caffeine and tannins. The tea infusion is white or light yellow and is the only tea considered non-astringent. White tea is naturally rich in antioxidants and polyphenols which help keep us healthy.
